Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome to Term 1, 2023.

Term 1 learning will include:

- InitialLit literacy lessons: Mrs Leov will be teaching the Kindergarten lessons. Mrs Geddes and Mrs Smith will be teaching the Year 1 lessons. Students will work on InitialLit and independent activities (reading, writing, letter activities, alphabets and games) once the day's lesson has been completed. InitialLit will be in the morning session.
- News and InitialLit storybook lessons will be taught in the middle session straight after recess followed by mathematics.
- Miss Spinelli will be teaching Personal Development and Health on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons, with our Term 1 unit being How Can I Keep Myself and Others Safe.
- The Inquisitive units for this term are Families and My History (History) and Living Things (Science).
- K-1 will be combining with Year 2 for sport, Friday middle session with Mrs Leov and Miss Beer.
- Library is Monday with Mrs Geddes. All students need a library bag to borrow. Students can only borrow if they have returned their books from the previous week. Library books are for enjoyment and should be read to your child by a parent, relative or older sibling. Reading books aloud to children stimulates their imagination and expands their understanding of the world. It helps them develop language and listening skills.
- **K-1 will be performing at the first assembly on Friday 24 February. Assembly begins at 2:10pm. All families are invited to attend. Videos and photos of your child performing may be taken for personal use but are not to be shared on any social media platform.**
