Update, Update, Update

There were a number of changes to our COVID-19 guidelines last week. Rapid Antigen Tests (RAT) are no longer required to be completed twice weekly by students and staff and only need to be done if your child displays symptoms. Four RAT kits per student were sent home last week and another four will be provided to all students in the coming weeks. They will be the final RAT kits provided to students and staff. Visitors are now able to attend school for events and activities as long as they sign in using the School's QR Code and follow COVID-19 guidelines eg double vaccination. Masks are still required by adults on site until the end of this week, Friday 4 March. Cohorts and classes are now free to mix as well.

to support Albury Wodonga Regional FoodShare

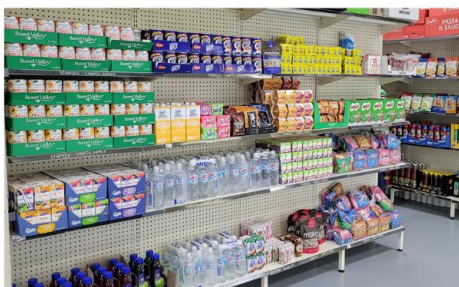


The long-term impacts from the coronavirus pandemic have placed a significant strain on families in the Albury Wodonga region.

The school office will collect any items anyone wishes to donate.



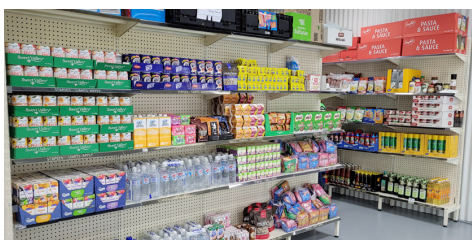
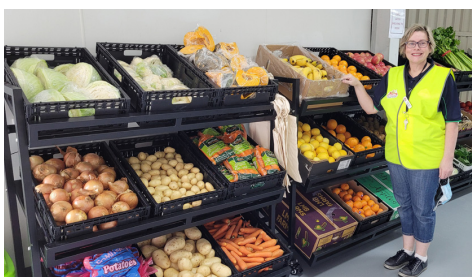
