As NAIDOC (National Aborigines and Islanders Day Observance Committee) Week will fall during the school holidays, 2 to 9 July, we will be celebrating Naidoc Week during National Reconciliation Week 27 May to 3 June. NAIDOC Week occurs annually in July and celebrates the history, culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. Next Friday 2 June, all students will be involved in NAIDOC Week activities. Students will be split into groups and rotate through the different activities during the day. On Thursday 1 June, our senior students will lead the pre-school students from the Culcairn Family Day Care in some Indigenious Games, which are sure to be enjoyed by all.

All students will be involved in Public Speaking activities over the next few weeks in their classes. Students will present their speeches to their class on different topics set by their class teacher. 4 or 5 students per year level will then present their speeches at assembly.
