3rd child at school \$70.00	4th child at school \$65.00

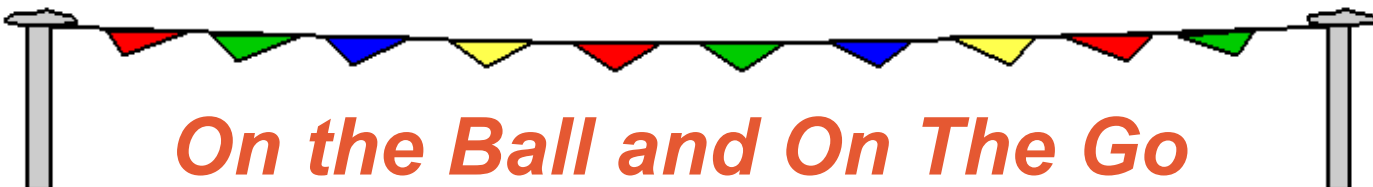

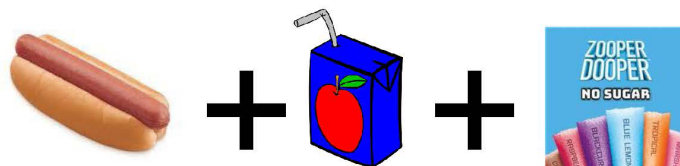
## Class 5-6
